Materials needed were discussed including embroidery hoops, fabric backgrounds (anything except white) that a full range of threads can be used and that accessories can also be added to the portraits, e.g., jewellery, etc. Illustrated photos and reference books were also shared with the membership.

Members were also informed that all skills and techniques are acceptable including digital/hand/machine embroidery, applique, tapestry, padded work, or a combination of some/all. Portraits can be realistic or cartoon-like, etc. Hoops need to be filled. Big and bold is the way to go!

We hope to have every member represented in the 'portrait gallery'.

The committee is to make a bulk purchase of large hoops which will then be sold to members at a discounted rate. Further information will be issued about this soon.

If you wish to take part the organisers are suggesting cross-stitched panels depicting scenes or concepts that have a connection with the place or nationality, represent strong feelings about the conflict, the disproportionate impact and burden on women, or, indeed, anything that comes to mind and feels relevant and to show we care about people innocently caught up in world politics, very far away from their ordinary, everyday lives....

The organisers are keen to get stitchers of all abilities involved. The finished pieces will be photographed and uploaded to a central website in such a way to make up the Palestinian flag. Your piece would need to be completed for Spring Fling 2025.
